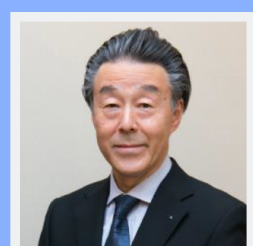
## Advice for American Students
